Please join us for the second annual Aikibojitsu training retreat campout held in beautiful Petrolia on California's Lost Coast. This is a family-oriented event. Kids and significant others are welcome. Fees only apply to active Aikibojitsu practitioners. We will be camping out in a landscape of coastal grasslands next to a gently flowing creek just a few miles from the Mattole River and wild ocean beaches.

Attendees will need to bring their own camping gear (tent, sleeping bag, etc), and food. Summer on the ranch is typically dry and sunny. It can also be very windy at times, so come ready to commune with the powers of nature! Petrolia is a remote, rural area with one restaurant and one general store.

Aikibojitsu is a beautiful and challenging art form of precise and flowing movements with a staff. Practitioners explore both the depths of silence and peaks of explosive power. Aikibojitsu is moving meditation, an archetypal call for practitioners to look deeply and directly at existence and our place within it.

Aikibojitsu is a highly sophisticated and powerful martial art whose real challenge comes down to confrontation with a simple stick of wood. There is no hiding from oneself in this confrontation because the staff is a perfect mirror.

Aikibojitsu is a compelling martial system for even the most experienced martial artist, but it is truly an art form for everyone. People begin study who have no martial background at all, while others who have extensive martial arts experience find Aikibojitsu to be an unusually powerful exploration of the true power of non-resistance.
